- 1 1L5 (One page lined, one page blank) ~ for RE.
- 1 20 page Clear file Waiata/Poetry
- 1 Art envelope (18N9) A3 size (Manilla) Only if your child needs a new one
- 1 LARGE box of tissues and another one in Term 3
- Journal bag (Large) ~ if your child does not already have one (for library books and notices)
- 1 Pencil case
- 1 Word card (Tent) (Available from the Office if you aren't able to source it)
- 1 Colouring in book for wet days
- 4 Whiteboard markers (Mixed colours)
- 1 Word Collection Book (available only from the Office ~ \$4.50)
